## **1 Introduction**

The *RFMSS-CSE Eglin Interface Companion Guide* is a companion to the *Range Facility Management Support System (RFMSS) User Manual* that introduces the features added to RFMSS 3.3.5 for the exclusive use of Eglin users when the Center Scheduling Enterprise (CSE) interface is enabled. It is not intended to be a substitute for the RFMSS User Manual.

## 2 General Administration Features

### 2.1 Administration > Background Jobs Page

CSE data is automatically imported on a daily basis. However, if a Functional Administrator (FA) needs updated CSE data at any time, a CSE data import can be conducted manually.

If RFMSS data matches CSE data by ID, the RFMSS record will be merged with the CSE record and the merged record will be marked as a CSE record.

On the Background Jobs page, an FA can import CSE Administration data, including Facilities, Airspace Subdivisions, Aircraft, and Support Items.

2. Click the **CSE Administration Data** button. A data import job is created with the Job Status of **SCHEDULED**.



Data import jobs that have completed have the Job Status of **COMPLETE**.

### 3 How to Use CSE Data

#### 3.1 Scheduling a Request with CSE Data

When a Unit user (below PEN-CUST 5 [Division]) schedules an activity for a request, facilities that have been imported from CSE are available for selection. For the purpose of this example, imported facility names start with "CSE." Click the **select** link for the facility you want to choose.

Once you have created an activity using imported CSE data, you can see a new column in the Activities Grid of the Request form called **CSE Mission Number**. By default, this column is the farthest to the right (which is why it is not visible in the figure above), but you can drag it to wherever you want it to appear in your display.



### 3.2 Approving a Request with CSE Data

When a Unit user with privileges at or above PEN-CUST 5 (Division) approves a request containing activities that use CSE data, and the status changes to PEN-CUST 5 (DIVISION), then the activities containing CSE data are sent to CSE for approval and CSE Mission Number assignment. This example begins with an upper-level Unit user accessing the request submitted in the previous example by its RCNI (17266) via Request Processing.


The Request Processing page for the activity includes a new column called **CSE Mission Number**. By default, this column is displayed farthest to the right, but you can drag it to wherever you want it to appear in the grid.



When the user selects the activity and sets the status to **Approved**, the Request Processing Confirmation page is displayed.



If an activity spans multiple days, each day of that activity shows up on this page as its own line when approving to PEN-CUST 5 or above. This is because CSE Missions cannot span more than one calendar day. Therefore, each day of this activity must be sent to CSE as a separate mission. The Event Notes column for each line shows two bullets: Activity will be sent to CSE; and Activity(s) spanning multiple days have been split into one activity per day for CSE.



When the user clicks the **Save** button, the Request Processing page is displayed showing the multiple, single-day activities that have been sent to CSE. The CSE Mission Number column remains blank, but after a short while, CSE responds by assigning a Mission Number, in turn letting you know that the activity is in the CSE system.

Once a CSE Mission Number has been assigned, unit users with a unit level below 5-DIVISION cannot modify the activity or change its status. The system displays the message, “Unit users having unit level below 5-DIVISION cannot modify any activity that already has a CSE mission number.”

If a scheduler or unit user at or above 5-DIVISION modifies an activity that already has a CSE Mission Number, changes are NOT sent to CSE. A message is displayed stating, “The activity change will not be sent to CSE because it already has a CSE mission number.”

Any duplicate events are displayed in the disallowed (lower) grid on this page.

When a multi-day event that has been set as Continuous is broken into single-day activities, the **Continuous** value for each day’s activity changes to **No**. However, the start and end times within the start and end date windows change to span the full 24-hour window (i.e., Start 00:00; End 23:59).

### 3.3 Viewing Activities after Submit Request and CSE Scheduler Review

This example continues using the same request via RCNI Search (17266). The request has been submitted, and CSE has assigned unique Mission Numbers to each day in this multi-day activity.
